

Note: All papers, letters and documents listed below are to be sent directly to the secretary of the sponsoring Rotary Club by the individuals whom this applicant has asked to provide this information.

1. Transcript of college record (an official copy of the grades, records, marks or other method used to indicate the academic proficiency of the applicant during the normal college program).
2. Letter from the head of the department of the school who supervised the applicant's major studies for which a degree has been or will be granted at the end of the current school year. The letter should attest to the applicant's scholarship, achievements, character, talents, leadership, interest in people and any other comments pertinent to a scholarship application.
3. Verification of one of the following necessary documents for international travel: passport, visa, immigration status.
4. Letter from a faculty member of the same school who is also qualified to attest to the applicant's qualifications.
5. Letters from two business or professional persons of the applicant's home city, not related to the applicant, who are qualified to attest to the character, intellectual ability, adaptability, seriousness of purpose, diligence, ability to communicate ideas, future potential, and fitness for receiving a scholarship.
6. If the study will be conducted in a language other than applicant's first language, a letter is required from a person qualified to comment on the proficiency of the applicant/s skill in the language of the proposed study.
7. A recent passport style photograph.

I understand that if I fail to comply with the guidelines stated above, or if I become physically unable to fulfill my year of scholarship or otherwise are unable to carry out my responsibilities and obligations of the award, that I may lose my scholarship.

I further understand that, if in the opinion of the school authorities my knowledge of the language used in the school is not sufficient to enable me to satisfactorily complete my work, I will voluntarily withdraw from school with the understanding that my scholarship will be revoked and nor further payments will be made.

Payments will be made at the beginning of each of two semesters to the school chosen by the applicant.
